

Arts, Crafts, and Camping Assistant Program Director

Minimum age 20, with camping experience required

As the Camping APD, you would

- Prepare camping sites
- Be responsible for making sure all campsites are ready for camping at any time.
- Check the weather, and announce at mealtimes what the weather is for camping conditions.
- Prepare any meals that wanted to be made outside
- Get s'more supplies ready
- Make sure all tents are in camping condition
- Organize and prepare activities and games that can be done while camping
- participate with cabin(s) that are camping
- Be responsible to start and put out the fire used to make any food
- Be in charge of crafts onsite and offsite for the summer
- Be willing and ready to change crafts if they aren't working
- Make sure totes are ready to go for offsite VBS crafts
- Be available in afternoons for A and C if needed
- Help stimulate creativity in campers

As an APD you would

- focus on counselors
- be excellent role models for staff
- be involved with all worships
- encourage positive behavior to counselors and campers alike
- help with KP
- have activities during the day/evening
- help put fire out
- work with other APDs to plan the best camping experience
- Help with canteen
- Participate in daily activities

There will be an APD leadership training before staff training. More details about when this training would be are included in the contract. Other expectations will be discussed and formed then with the other APDs.
