Minimum age 18, one year out of high school

As a UMM counselor, you need:

- A willingness to share your life with others around you
- An appreciation of nature and the outdoors as a creation of God

As a UMM counselor, you will be responsible to:

- The Program Director in terms of training, work assignments, Vacation Bible School assignments, camp program, and personnel policies and practices.
- An APD (Assistant Program Director) if the Program Director is not present

As a UMM counselor, your general responsibilities would be:

- To participate in:
 - all camp activities
 - to attend a two week before camp staff training
 - program planning
 - staff meetings
 - sweet corn festival
 - weekend activities
 - other specifics that the Executive or Program director give you
- Be responsibly alert for the health and safety of all campers
- Be responsible for the stewardship of all camp facilities and equipment
- Encourage positive behavior in campers
- Facilitate assigned cleaning duties of your campers
- Understand, maintain and carry out the camp standards and policies
- Be willing to help out with other specific activities or areas

As a UMM counselor, your specific responsibilities would be:

- To be with your campers at all times
- Be responsible for the safety and health of your campers at all times
- Be responsible for up to 10 campers at a time in a cabin unless otherwise specified or special arrangements have been made.
- Be a positive presence within the group, helping plan and implement activities.
- Remain in the cabin each night with your group.
- Enforce the camp standards, policies, stewardship, and fun.
- Facilitate a daily Bible study.
- Assist in developing and leading worships.
- Assist & participate in Arts and Crafts.
- Handle all duties carefully and efficiently.
- Carry out the camp program, philosophy, and practices outlined in the staff policy handbook.
- Travel to various communities to lead Vacation Bible School
- Participate and assist in developing and leading Sunday morning services at your assigned VBS site.
- Providing service for projects and other programs requested by churches and communities.
